

Simple Usage Tips for your “Informer” Micro Camera:

(PROFESSIONAL MODEL)

Congratulations on your purchase of our Professional Model Informer Camera! You’ll find that it’s incredibly easy to operate the video/audio quality is excellent.

CHARGING: Connect the camera to the included USB port and then connect it to your computer or our optional power adapter if you purchased one; allow your camera to charge for about 3 full hours before you use it the first time. Subsequent charges need only be for 1-2 hours max.

LOW LIGHT READY: We’ve installed a low light (1 LUX) capable image chip into this pro model so that you can use it in lower light levels than some of our other mini camera models. This will tend to “brighten” your images when taken outdoors or in high light level conditions.

POWER ON AND OFF: When your camera is OFF – you will not see any LED light at the top the camera. Press and HOLD the Power button for 3-5 seconds, it will turn ON and the blue light will begin to flash – this is the STANDBY MODE.

RECORDING VIDEO WITH AUDIO: When you are in the STANDBY mode with the blue light flashing, simply press and release the BOTTOM BUTTON [on the lower right side of the camera] (# 6 on page 8 in your User’s Manual) to begin recording video. The blue light will remain STEADY ON while video is being recorded. Press and release the same button again to stop recording and to save your file. Too easy!

TAKING STILL IMAGES: In STANDBY mode, with the blue light flashing, press and release the TOP BUTTON [on the lower right side of the camera] (# 5 on page 8 in your User’s Manual) to take a still image. The blue light will remain STEADY ON (only momentarily) while your picture is being taken and saved. Too easy!

File Playback: Use the included USB cable to connect your Pro Informer to your PC or Laptop USB port. Your computer should recognize the device automatically. When you open the window for your Micro Camera – you’ll see all of your saved files. They’re saved in “.AVI” file format which can be viewed with your Windows Media player that is probably already installed on your PC. If you do not have it installed on your PC, then please know that any media player that recognizes .AVI files will work. If you cannot play the files on your computer – then please go to www.videolan.org to download their free media player. That’s it! After just a few uses, your Micro Informer will become second nature to you. Enjoy!
